

Loading Additional Guide Information (Listings)

You can load up to seven days of guide data for the program guide. The actual number of days available depends on many factors. When you request program guide data beyond what is initially loaded (typically 3-4 days), it is necessary for the system to load this new data on the settop. You can only load and view one new time frame segment at a time. A segment is dependent on the cable provider (for example, a segment might be 8 hours or 12 hours of information). When you load additional segments, the new segment swaps with another time frame.

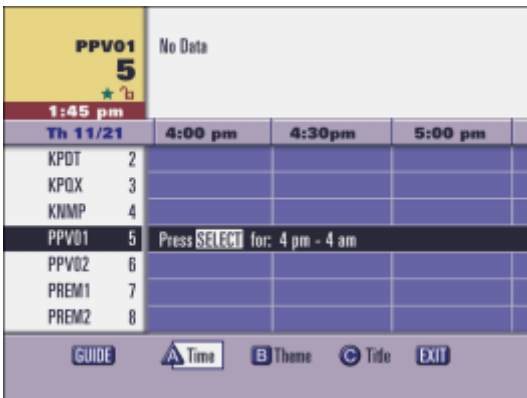
You load a new time frame segment from the time grid display (not the theme or title display). As a result of the data load, there is a minimal time delay in retrieving the information. During the time the data is loading, you receive a confirmation message; during this time, you can scroll through existing data, exit and enter the guide, perform other guide functions, or watch TV.

To load additional program guide data

- 1 Press the GUIDE button and the time grid displays.
- 2 Press the DAY+ button or scroll to the desired day. A right arrow and “More Data” indicates that there is additional data available to load.



- 3 Press the right arrow button and note the time frame stated in the display (for example 4am-4pm).



- 4 Continue pressing the right arrow button to highlight the desired time frame. Press the SELECT button to load the data.

Note: It takes about one-half minute to load the data. An hourglass displays in the grid. As soon as it is loaded, it displays. During the time that the data is loading, you can exit the guide, change channels and so forth.
